The LIFE CERSUDS project demonstrator is visited by representatives of the European Commission

• On 13 and 14 February, the representatives of the European Commission responsible for the supervision and monitoring of the LIFE CERSUDS project met in situ the demonstrator of the sustainable urban drainage system located in Benicassim.

On 13 and 14 February, the Instituto de Tecnología Cerámica (ITC) as coordinator of the LIFE CERSUDS Ceramic Sustainable Urban Drainage System project, received a visit from representatives of the European Commission responsible for supervising and monitoring the project, in order to meet all the participants, know the progress of the activities included in it and visit the demonstrator, in Calle Torre Sant Vicent de Benicàssim (Castellón) to know the finished work in situ.

LIFE CERSUDS is financed by the LIFE Programme of the European Union under the reference: LIFE 15 CCA / ES / 000091, and also with the support of the Valencian Institute of Business Competitiveness (IVACE) of the Generalitat Valenciana.

In addition to the ITC as coordinator, the Benicàssim City Council, the Polytechnic University of Valencia (UPV), the Bologna Ceramic Centre (CCB-Italy), CHM Obras e Infraestructuras, S.A., the Centro Tecnológico da Cerâmica e do Vidro (CTCV-Portugal) and the company Trencadís de Sempre, S.L., all of whose representatives took part in this meeting, participate in it.

LIFE CERSUDS, awarded.

LIFE CERSUDS has already won three awards: one, awarded by AEIPRO (Asociación Española de Dirección e Ingeniería de Proyectos) the Spanish association for civil management and projects engineering, to the best communication during the XXII Congreso Internacional de Dirección e Ingeniería de Proyectos (CIDIP 2018), held in July 2018 in Madrid. A second prize has been the recognition of the European Union through the InvestEU program, for which it has been selected together with only one other project among all those financed by the LIFE Program of the EC in Spain, to carry out a nationwide dissemination campaign by the prestigious agency Burson Cohn and Wolfe, and more recently, by the Diputación de Castellón, within its contest "Som Cerámica" to the City Council of Benicàssim for the merit in the use of ceramics in the urban environment in an innovative way.

In this way, LIFE CERSUDS is already a reference in innovation in the field of sustainable urban drainage systems, and will be presented on 20 February at 12:15 pm, in the conference: "Innovation in urban drainage management: efficiency and sustainability for the adaptation of our cities to climate change", an initiative within the framework of the XXV Edition of the Week of Civil Engineering and the Environment, organized by the School of Roads, Canals and Ports (ETSICCP) of the Universitat Politècnica de València, in building 4G.
